Additions

Journals

Our Cambridge University Press (CUP) e-journals deal through OhioLINK has expanded as of 1/1/22. The expanded deal adds access to all CUP e-journals (220+ new titles) and open access publishing benefits. This Read and Publish deal provides UA authors with no-charge open access publishing for articles accepted for publication in CUP journals. OhioLINK has provided additional details about open access publishing through this deal which can be [accessed here](#). This is the second Read and Publish deal provided by UL. Our other current deal is with the Company of Biologists.

Our existing subscription to [Oxford Scholarship Online](#) has been upgraded to include the following subjects:

Cancellations

While UL continues to work hard on cost control and budget management, some cancellations are still necessary at this time for us to be able to meet all of our commitments.

University Libraries will provide as much notice as possible when resources are to be discontinued in an effort to lessen disruption to our users. Reductions to library collections will continue to be shared via Digest updates and directly with departments. Databases

Our subscription to *Birds of the World* was not renewed. Access ended in November 2021.

Our subscription to *Psychiatry Online Premium* has been downgraded to *Psychiatry Online Core*. The following content changes went into effect on 1/1/22:

- Loss of access to the e-journal *The Journal of Neuropsychiatry and Clinical Neurosciences*.
- Loss of access to supplemental *DSM-5* titles such as *DSM-5 Clinical Cases*.
 - Note: We have retained online access to the *DSM-5* in English and Spanish. This content will be updated to the *DSM-5-TR* when it is released.
- Loss of access to several additional American Psychiatric Association e-books.

Resource Notes and Updates

The Wolters Kluwer database *Cheetah* has been renamed *VitalLaw*. This change is reflected in the A-Z list and our catalog.
