E-books

Databases

The Literary Encyclopedia

University Libraries has added [The Literary Encyclopedia](#) to our list of databases. The Literary Encyclopedia is a constantly updated repository of authoritative reference work about literary and cultural history. All articles are solicited by invitation from specialist scholars in higher education institutions all over the world, including some of UA's own faculty in the English Department.

Access Anesthesiology

A five-year subscription to [Access Anesthesiology](#) is now accessible. This resource is especially helpful for our Anesthesiology students and includes reference, research, and curricular instruction. Access Anesthesiology is updated regularly and covers the entire spectrum of anesthesiology from the basics to specialty-specific content that can be viewed on any device.

Resource Notes and Updates

ZipSearch and E-Journal Finder

ZipSearch and E-Journal finder are getting a new look! EBSCO has updated the interfaces for their discovery products and University Libraries will be moving to the new interfaces starting in mid-July. EBSCO Consumer Health Complete

EBSCO has added new content and features to Consumer Health Complete. Content includes an updated collection of health reference e-books, updated pamphlets and health reports. The new interface includes the ability to browse trending topics, accessibility improvements, and citation export. Consumer Health Complete is provided by University Libraries as part of the OhioLINK Base Pack of databases available to all members.

Oxford's New E-Book Platform

Oxford will be migrating their e-book content onto their Oxford Academic platform that already hosts their e-journal content in July. All OhioLINK members have access to Oxford Scholarship Online (OSO), University Press Scholarship Online (UPSO), and Very Short Introductions e-books from Oxford University Press. These resources will be available on the Oxford Academic site starting on July 14, and the legacy platforms will redirect to the new Oxford Academic site on **July 20** for Very Short Introductions and on **July 27** for OSO and UPSO.
