E-books

Diversity, Equity, Inclusion E-Books

A consortial collection of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion E-Books is now available through OhioLINK. The funding for these books came through a grant to OhioLINK from the American Rescue Plan Act and funding from the Institute of Museum and Library Studies. This consortial collection allows all OhioLINK member libraries to have access to a base e-book collection in this important and under-resourced area for teaching and research.

The first phase of these e-books are locally available in ZipSearch and UL's catalog. There will be a Phase 2 update to the collection in the future. You can find a list of the DEI e-books in the UL catalog under [OhioLINK electronic book—DEI collection](#).

Resource Notes and Updates

Artstor

Artstor's content, key resources, and functionality will be moving to JSTOR. The Artstor website will be retired on August 1, 2024. For more information, please visit [Artstor's migration guide](#) on JSTOR's site.

Library Connect Ohio (LCO) is a collaboration between INFOhio (the K-12 library consortium), Ohio Public Library Information Network (OPLIN), the public library consortium, OhioLINK, and the State Library of Ohio to provide all Ohioans access to a core collection of shared digital resources, also known as the Ohio Web Library. Proposals for LCO resources are selected through a competitive bid process every 5 years, with the final set of resources evaluated and selected by librarian stakeholder groups from academic, public, and school libraries.

The recent selection process added [ProQuest CultureGrams](#), but LCO will no longer provide access to Gale Kids Infobits and Transparent Language Online. These changes will take effect July 1st, 2023.
